Carolina Shores Bowling League Rules 2022-2023

BOARD OF DIRECTORS INCLUDES:

1. **SCHEDULE.** The League will bowl on Tuesdays, commencing September 13, 2022. All scheduled matches will start at 5:40. Practice will commence at 5:30 weekly.

The season will include 26 weeks of bowling, including the 2 position rounds. Bowling will not be conducted on November 22, December ~~24~~ and December 27 due to the holiday season. The season will end at the conclusion of bowling on March 23, 2023.

2. **SANCTION.** The League will not be sanctioned.
3. **FEES.** The bowling fee for each week is \$17.00 per individual. Bowling fees for the last two weeks of the season should be paid by Week 2 of the season. The Secretary/Treasurer shall be paid \$.50 cents per bowler, per week, payable at the end of the season.

Of the \$17.00 bowling fee, \$12.25 per person will be paid to Little River Lanes. The remaining \$4.75 per person will go into the Prize Fund for distribution following the season. The Prize Fund will include team and individual prizes, the Secretary fee, and the League banquet, if so voted upon.

4. **LEAGUE FUNDS.** A funding account currently exists at Truist Bank, in which funds are deposited weekly during the bowling season. Withdrawals shall be made with joint signatures of at least two authorized league officers. The League President shall audit the account at least once a month.

- 5. AWARDS.** The President shall appoint at least three members to submit prize lists which must be approved by the Board of Directors. To qualify for an individual award, a bowler must bowl at least two thirds of the scheduled games. A team may qualify for only one award. An individual may qualify for one award, both men and women.
6. **AVERAGES.** To start the new season, a bowler's average will carry over from last year. A new average will be established after 9 games are bowled. A new bowler will establish an average after the first 3 games bowled. Handicap shall be 90% of 200. Absent scores shall be a bowler's average minus 10 pins. Vacancy scores shall be 120, with handicap based on that score.
7. **TEAM ROSTERS.** Rosters shall be limited to 4 players. One member of the opposite sex is required on a team. Any roster changes must be reported prior to the time that the new member bowls. New members may not be added to the roster during the final two weeks of the season without approval of the Board of Directors.
8. **LEGAL LINEUP.** At least one or more eligible players must be present to constitute a legal line up. Tardy bowlers may enter the game provided three frames have not been completed. Missing frames may be made up.
9. **SUBSTITUTES.** Substitutions are allowed. A team may bowl with up to three substitutes, as long as there is a legal lineup (see 8 above). Substitutes with an average of 190 or above are not allowed. Substitutes are not allowed for a position round. Substitutes may be of either sex, allowing a male to sub for a female and vice versa
10. **FORFEITS.** The team present will have to bowl within ten pins per player or 40 pins per team in order to earn the victory points.
11. **PRE/POST BOWLS.** If a game needs to be pre- or post-bowled the opposing team captain must be notified. The League President or Secretary and the Little River Bowling Alley must also be notified. If not notified, all games pre- or post-bowled will be forfeited. Pre- or post-bowling shall be accomplished during the 13-day period, encompassing the same week as scheduled bowling.
